## What is the California State Library Parks Pass and who can use it?

In partnership with the First Partner's Office and the California State Library, the California State Library Parks Pass program provides a free vehicle day use entry for one passenger vehicle with capacity of nine people or less or one highway licensed motorcycle at 200+ participating state park units to library card holders.

# Who can borrow the Library Park Pass?

Anyone who is 18 and over with a valid library card that is in good standing

# How long can I borrow the Library Parks Pass?

The Library Park Pass can be checked out for two weeks

## Can I check out more than one Library Parks Pass?

One Library Park Pass per patron at a time

## **Can I renew the Library Parks Pass?**

In order to provide wide access the Library Parks Passes are not renewable. The Park Pass must be returned by the due date. The pass will be reported lost and deactivated after due date if not returned.

## What if I lose the Library Parks Pass? Is there a cost for a lost pass?

Please inform the library if the pass is lost. There is a \$5.00 processing fee for a lost pass.

#### Can I place a hold on the Library Parks Pass?

You cannot place a hold online. Please call the library to ask if a Library Parks Pass is available. If available, you can place a telephone hold for the day. Pass must be picked up by end of business day.

# What are the terms and conditions of the Library Parks Pass?

- The pass is valid for entry of one passenger vehicle with capacity of nine people or less or one highway licensed motorcycle at participating state park units.
- Passes will be valid at 200+ participating state park units. The pass will not be honored at state park units operated by federal or local government and private agencies or concessionaires, or at parks that do not require a vehicle day-use pass, such as marine areas or kayak-in parks.
- The pass is not valid for per-person entry or tour fees (such as museums), boat use, camping, group use or sites, special events, additional/extra vehicle fees, sanitation disposal use or for supplemental fees.
